General Use Warnings

- This product is not intended to be used with e-liquid which contains nicotine.
- This product is not intended for non-smokers. Do not use if you currently do not smoke tobacco or vape.
- Do not allow others to use your device at any time.
- Keep all directions for future use and use only as instructed.
- This is not a smoking cessation device, nor is it intended to be one. If you are trying to quit smoking or vaping, please consult your doctor.
- You must be of legal smoking age in your jurisdiction to use this product.
- Only use hybrid safe atomisers with a protruding pin on this device.
- Do not use while driving.
- Use outdoors and away from the vicinity of humans and pets.

- If you hear anything unusual from the device, immediately stop using it and take it to your seller.

Battery Warnings

- **Battery recommendations: Sony VTC5a or LG HB6.**
- Lithium-ion batteries are volatile. They may burn or explode with improper use.
- Do not use or charge with non-approved devices.
- Over use of vaping apparatus may result in product overheating, malfunction and/or cause burns.
- Do not leave product unattended while charging at anytime or overnight. Do not charge in your vehicle.
- Keep away from high heat, direct sunlight, cold temperatures, humidity and water.
- Do not mix battery brands (if device takes more than 1 battery to function).
